ESSENTIAL INFORMATION MOROCCO

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

Your passport needs to be valid for at least six (6) months after your journey ends, and should have a minimum of one (1) blank visa page for entry and exit stamps.

Holders of U.S. and Canadian passports are not required to obtain a tourist visa for entry into Morocco for stays of up to 90 days. On arrival in Morocco, you will be given an "Entry Number." Please keep this number easily accessible as you will be asked to provide it at every hotel on your itinerary.

Citizens of other countries should contact the appropriate consular office for entry requirements pertaining to their journey.

CASH & CREDIT CARDS

Cash transactions should be made in local currency. Major credit cards are widely accepted for goods and services at hotels, restaurants and larger shops, however be prepared to pay cash at *souks* and smaller shops. Access to ATM machines is widespread in cities and towns, but may be limited in rural areas.

OF SPECIAL NOTE: SMOKING IN MOROCCO

Smoking is very commonplace in Morocco and you should be prepared to encounter smoking, even in public places that would be deemed smoke-free in the U.S. such as restaurants, shops, museums etc. This also extends into hotels, including hotel rooms categorized as "non-smoking." While every effort will be made to secure non-smoking rooms when requested, there is no guarantee that smoking did not take place in that room when occupied by previous guests.

PACKING LIST & BAGGAGE RESTRICTIONS

Should your journey include any internal flights within Morocco, passengers are allowed one piece of checked baggage per person with a maximum weight of approximately 44 pounds (20 kilograms). Total dimensions of the checked bag must not exceed 62 inches (160 centimeters). Dimensions for checked bags are calculated by adding together the width, height and depth of the piece of luggage.

For carry-on baggage, passengers are allowed one piece per person with a maximum weight of approximately 22 pounds (10 kilograms). Total dimensions of the carry-on bag are not to exceed 22 inches (55 centimeters) x 16 inches (40 centimeters) x 8 inches (20 centimeters) including handles, pockets and wheels.

Please use the provided A&K luggage tags, even if your bags already have ID tags. This makes it easier for A&K staff to collect and manage your luggage for you.

Clothing

Choose versatile, casual clothing that can be layered if the weather (or level of air-conditioning) requires. Smart casual attire is appropriate for evenings. Formal clothing is not necessary.

Temples, mosques and other religious sites require conservative dress. Both sexes should cover their arms, legs and shoulders (women should pack a scarf for this purpose.) Wear or carry a pair of socks when sightseeing, since shoes must be removed when visiting certain religious sites.

Please Note: In Morocco it is extremely common to encounter restroom attendants in airports, bazaars, and other sites frequented by tourists. While not compulsory, it is customary to tip these individuals an amount equal to approximately .25 to .50 cents.
