We exclusively charter and then specially configure these ships to limit capacity to 199 guests (from a maximum of 244), affording a personnel-to-guest ratio of 1 to 1.2 and a private balcony with every stateroom and suite.

Small Explorer Ships for Cultural and Warm-Water Voyages

When it comes to expedition vessels, small means versatile. These small explorer yachts are perfectly sized to access the exotic ports and harbors closed to bigger ships. When exclusively chartered and configured for our expeditions, these vessels feature a capacity limited to 148 guests (from a maximum of 184), a private balcony with every stateroom and suite and an intimate 1 to 1.2 personnel-to-guest ratio.

We Sail on Sustainable Small Ships Utilizing Innovative Technology
Each luxury expedition cruiser and small explorer ship we charter
features energy-efficient engines, reduced fuel consumption using only
environmentally compliant fuel types, and computerized dynamic
positioning systems that minimize the need to anchor in fragile marine
reserves. All carbon emissions from our cruises are 100 percent offset, and an
Environmental Officer oversees each voyage to make sure all environmental
protocols are observed to the letter.

We Practice Conservation and Minimize Waste

On voyages aboard luxury expedition cruisers and small explorer ships, we provide a complimentary reusable water bottle for every guest and significantly reduce other single-use plastics such as straws, laundry bags, cups and food containers. More than half of all packaging is recycled on board while the rest is fully tracked, ensuring nothing ends up in the water or on land.

Our Chartered Ships Are Certified Sustainable

All of our chartered luxury expedition cruisers and small explorer ships have been awarded the CLEANSHIP or CLEANSHIP SUPER label by Bureau Veritas, certifying their ecologically responsible operations and allowing you to explore with peace of mind.

Our Environmental Commitment to the Galápagos

We are committed to conserving the Galápagos Islands' precious natural resources at sea with a host of environmentally friendly operating procedures and onboard upgrades, such as advanced wastewater treatment systems. On land, we've partnered with a regional airline to open an onsite recycling facility on San Cristóbal, saving an estimated 10 tons of waste from being landfilled on the islands per year.





Our projects pioneer transformation in health, education, enterprise and conservation to drive meaningful change and uplift thousands of people around the world. Here are just a few of the ways in which A&K Philanthropy is helping to make a difference.

EDUCATION

Education is the key to equality of opportunity and to the conservation of our whole world. AKP partners with underserved communities to build schools, provide books and free school meals and to foster teacher training programs. The Children of the Rainbow School (Fundacion Niños del Arco Iris) was founded to serve one of these communities in Peru's Sacred Valley. Alongside literacy and language lessons are sessions on nutrition, personal and social development, and respecting and caring for local plants and wildlife.

ENVIRONMENT

Through education programs with local communities and collaborating with government organizations, A&K Philanthropy promotes the protection of our planet's fragile ecosystems, from the rainforests of Uganda to the marine reserves of the Galápagos Islands. Save the Albatross is devoted to helping protect the albatross and other Antarctic seabirds from becoming accidentally tangled in deep sea fishing lines.

HEALTH

Safe water is a basic human need. It is a UN Sustainable Development Goal to ensure every human has access to safe and affordable drinking water by 2030, and to this end A&K Philanthropy has invested in the provision of clean-water wells, water filters, and hygiene education. Since 2017, A&K Philanthropy has partnered with LifeStraw, a leader in accessible filtering and purification systems, to provide safe water to thousands of children in India, Kenya, Myanmar, Tanzania, Uganda, Vietnam and Zambia.

ENTERPRISE

Our community-led enterprise projects are designed to empower people to learn, earn and progress in the destinations where our guests travel. We foster local partnerships to launch start-ups, including the Sishemo Bead Studio in Zambia's Nakatindi Village, which helps a small group of local women to support their families and community through traditional glass bead-making.

JUL 25: Arrive Oslo, Norway

Arrive in Oslo, your gateway to the Arctic. Upon arrival, you are met and escorted to the conveniently located Radisson Blu Airport Hotel. This evening, gather for a welcome briefing and dinner. Meals: D

JUL 26: **Longyearbyen** | Gateway to Adventure Board your charter flight to Longyearbyen, the capital of Svalbard, also known as Spitsbergen, the sovereign Arctic Archipelago of Norway. It is one of the most remote groups of islands on the planet, with nearly two-thirds of its surface covered in luminous glaciers. This afternoon, board your luxury expedition cruiser. **Meals**: B L D

JUL 27: **Svalbard Islands** | Northern Outpost Awake to your first morning aboard as your vessel cruises up the Svalbard coast. Today's explorations may feature Ny-Alesund, home to a polar research station and the northernmost post office in the world. Back aboard, enjoy a welcome dinner hosted by the Captain. Meals: B L D

JUL 28: **Svalbard Islands** | Glacial Archipelago Today, your vessel sets course for Monacobreen. Formerly known as Monaco Bay, this glacier reaches down into Spitsbergen and is frequented by polar bears, harbor and bearded seals, walrus and a multitude of seabirds. You may also cruise through Liefdefjorden (The Love Fjord), another excellent area for spotting polar bears. **Meals**: **B** L **D**

JUL 29: **Svalbard Islands** | Realm of the Polar Bear Conditions permitting, you may set out on a Zodiac excursion along steep cliffs harboring vast colonies of auk diving birds. This afternoon, your Captain and Expedition

Team may take advantage of sea conditions and arrange an invigorating and scenic hike ashore. Meals: B L D

JUL 30: **Svalbard Islands** | Majestic Scenery Your expedition continues northward as you take in breathtaking mountains, glaciers and icebergs and keep watch for polar bears, Brünnich's guillemots and numerous species of kittiwakes. **Meals: B L D**

JUL 31: **Svalbard Islands** | Tip of the Archipelago The day's explorations may take you to the most northerly region of the Svalbard Islands. **Meals: BLD**

AUG1: **Greenland Sea** | Enrichment at Sea Cruise south through the Greenland Sea as your Expedition Team lectures on the wildlife, history and geology of the Svalbard Islands. **Meals: B L D**

AUG 2: Jan Mayen | Glacier-Cloaked Volcano
The day's planned shore excursion is Jan Mayen, a rugged island dominated by the 7,500-foot Beerenberg Volcano, the world's northernmost active volcano. With special permission and conditions permitting, land on this rarely visited island to see its meteorological station and discover colonies of northern fulmar, little auk, thick-billed guillemot and black guillemot. Meals: B L D

AUG 3: Ittoqqortoormiit, Greenland | Remote Village Today, ice conditions permitting, disembark for a visit to the small settlement of Ittoqqortoormiit, one of the most isolated villages in Greenland. Meals: B L D



AUG 4: Scoresby Sound | Endless Fjords

Your Captain charts a course across the Greenland Sea, skirting the Arctic ice edge toward Greenland's rarely visited eastern coast and Scoresby Sound, the largest and longest fjord system in the world. You may embark on Zodiac excursions through the fjord's intricate network, taking in its islands and icebergs while searching for Arctic and musk fox. Meals: B L D

AUG 5: **Denmark Strait** | Enrichment at Sea Cruise the Denmark Strait as you relax or watch for seabirds and whales from the deck between insightful lectures from your Expedition Team. Meals: B L D

AUG 6: Husavik, Iceland | Whale-Watching Haven Today, opt to visit picturesque Husavik and its fascinating whale museum. Supported by A&K Philanthropy, the museum is one of the world's foremost whale research centers. Alternatively, choose to embark on a scenic whale-watching tour, or perhaps set off for Godafoss Falls and geothermal Lake Myvatn. Tonight, gather for a special farewell reception and dinner. Meals: B L D

AUG 7: Iceland's Westfjords | Lava & Ice-Carved Lands Explore the Westfjords of Iceland, a remote region of small settlements interspersed amid spectacular mountains and coves. Here, take in the stunning views as you enjoy a leisurely walk or embark on a more vigorous trek ashore. Meals: B L D

AUG8: Depart Reykjavik

This morning, disembark your expedition cruiser in Reykjavik and transfer to the airport for your onward departure or discover more of Iceland on the post-tour extension. Meals: B

DAY 1: Arrive Athens, Greece

Arrive in Athens, where you are met and transferred to the Hotel Grande Bretagne for a welcome briefing and reception.

DAY 1: Arrive Guayaquil, Ecuador

Arrive in Guayaquil, where you are met and transferred to the elegant Hotel del Parque in the heart of the city.

DAY 2: San Cristóbal Island | Gateway to Adventure Fly to Puerto Baquerizo Moreno, the capital of the Galápagos Islands and San Cristóbal's main port. Upon arrival, hop aboard a Zodiac for the brisk ride to your luxurious adventure yacht anchored in the bay. After lunch on board, sail to León Dormido (Sleeping Lion), a remnant of a tuff cone formation rising some 500 feet from the ocean. Observe the variety of species that inhabit its cliffs, including the blue-footed booby, Nazca booby and frigatebird. Tonight, join the Captain, crew and Expedition Team for a cocktail reception and welcome dinner. Meals: B L D

DAY 3: **Genovesa Island** | Prince Philip's Steps
On Genovesa Island, visit Prince Philip's Steps, one of the islands' premier birdwatching destinations. After lunch, explore the cliffs by kayak, stand-up paddleboard, or on a deepwater snorkeling excursion from the Zodiac. This afternoon, arrive at Darwin Bay, a coral sand beach where lava gulls gather by tide pools. Wade out to swim or snorkel with playful sea lions in these warmer northern-route waters. Meals: B L D

DAY 4: Santa Cruz Island | Bachas Beach & Dragon Hill Drop anchor on the northern side of Santa Cruz Island to visit Playa Las Bachas (Bachas Beach), home to bright pink flamingos that feed on the interior lagoons. Stroll along its long, glittering white sand beach. After lunch on board, step ashore at Cerro Dragón (Dragon Hill) and climb its slopes to take in magnificent views of the bay. Meals: B L D

DAY 6: Fernandina Island | Punta Espinoza & Tagus Cove Arrive at Fernandina Island's Punta Espinoza to encounter its sea lion colonies and other diverse species. Watch as the resident bulls carefully guard their harems and keep lookout for sharks that threaten the colony's pups. Glimpse some of the hundreds of marine iguanas that share this rocky domain, the largest colony in the Galápagos, as they warm themselves along the rugged shoreline. Next, land at Isabela Island's Tagus Cove, a former anchorage of pirates and whalers. Explore by Zodiac or kayak in search of Galápagos penguins, boobies, pelicans and other seabirds. After dinner, go topside to take in the sparkling night sky as you cross the Equator for the final time on your Galápagos voyage.

DAY 7: **Rábida Island** | Red Sands & Saltwater Lagoons Today, the dark red sands of Rábida Island welcome you ashore. Considered the geographic center of the Galápagos,



Rábida's volcanic rocks are the most diverse in the archipelago. Hike a trail beside the shore, keeping watch for marine iguanas, mockingbirds, yellow warblers and several species of Darwin's finch. Continue to a saltwater lagoon where migrating greater flamingos flock. Then, take advantage of the option to snorkel among a large colony of playful, inquisitive sea lions. After lunch on board, resume your explorations in this fascinating corner of the Galápagos Islands. Meals: B L D

DAY 8: Santa Cruz Island | Into the Highlands
Awake in Santa Cruz's lively harbor of Academy Bay.
